EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

1. This ERP shall be adhered to by all personnel attending Op: STARBURST. Any question thereof can be directed to the OIC, 2IC, or CO respectively.

Medical Emergencies

- 2. <u>Physical Ailment / Injury</u>. Any injury requiring first aid shall be reported to the First Aid Officer as soon as possible.
- a. <u>Serious Injury</u>. A serious injury includes broken bones, serious lacerations or contusions, allergic or other physiological result requiring immediate emergency medical care, or any other injury which the First Aid Officer deems serious.
- b. <u>Minor Injury</u>. A minor injury includes small lacerations or contusions which can be repaired through the use of heat / cold packs, bandages, etc.
- 3. <u>Emergency Medical Services</u>. Local emergency medical services can be contacted by dialing 911 using the Sqn Duty Phone. Any call to emergency services must be approved by either the First Aid Officer, OIC, 2IC, or CO.
- 4. First Aid Station. A first aid station shall be set up in the Command Building, manned 24hrs/day.

Adverse Weather Conditions

- 5. The accommodations at Camp BEL include a hard-walled shelter building, which can withstand usual regional weather conditions.
- 6. Daily weather reports shall be viewed by the daily Duty Staff and communicated to the OIC/2IC to determine suitability and safety for activities. Any adverse and abnormal weather conditions wherein the on-site facilities cannot provide adequate safety will require the immediate evacuation from the training site to the Brantford Armoury.
- 7. The decision to cancel the FTX rests with the OIC, however should the CO deem it appropriate, he may recommend the OIC to do so.

<u>Fire</u>

- 8. If a fire occurs at the training facility that is deemed out of control, all members shall meet at the meeting point, described during the safety briefing. All members shall know this location.
- 9. An attendance shall be taken by the CIC/C2IC and verified by the 2IC. The OIC shall evaluate the condition of the fire and determine if the FTX is still viable.
- 10. No cadet shall attempt to fight a fire.

Other

11. Direction during any other unforeseen emergency shall be taken from the OIC, 2IC, or CO.
